Advantages

- Experience the rigor of college level coursework
- Demonstrates readiness for college
- Saving money on college tuition
- Increase likelihood of graduating from college in 4 years or less
- Metro grading scale (10 point)

Disadvantages

- Real college courses
 - o Means a college transcript
- Overwhelming workload
 - o Means additional stress
- Not guaranteed to transfer to college
 - Means may have to take the class again


