Gretna High School Graduation Requirements

Students graduating from Gretna High School must successfully complete 46 credits during grades 9-12. Each class is worth 2 credits for the year if it meets every day (1 credit per semester). If it meets every other day, such as PE 9 or PE 10, it is worth 1 credit for the year (.5 credits per semester).

Dual Credit

...taking a college course for both high school and college credit, during the high school day, on the high school campus, taught by qualified high school instructors.

Advantages

- Experience the rigor of college level coursework
- Demonstrates readiness for college
- Saving money on college tuition
- Increase likelihood of graduating from college in 4 years or less
- Metro grading scale (10 point)

Disadvantages

- Real college courses
 - Means a college transcript
- Overwhelming workload
 - Means additional stress
- Not guaranteed to transfer to college
 - Means may have to take the class again
